AN IMPORTANT INFORMATION: The name of the student who remains absent from the college for seven consecutive days will be struck off from the college rolls. He/she will have to repay all the admission charges to regularise his/her admission in case he/she wants so.

General Information Regarding Admission

- 1. The students seeking admission to the college are required to note the following instructions as guidelines.
 - a) To fill up all particulars on the prescribed admission form completely in their own handwriting. Incomplete form shall be rejected.
 - b) To affix a coloured passport size copy of their latest photograph on the specified space and sign on it. Also deposit three passport size coloured photographs along with the Admission Form.
 - c) Bring the following documents at the time of admission
 - i] Original Certificate of having passed the lower examination.
 - ii] Original Character Certificate from head of the institution last attended.
 - d) To appear personally for interview in the Principal's Office along with above documents.
- 2. A scheduled caste or backward class student is required to attach/submit with the admission form, a certificate from the competent authority in this regard.
- 3. Foreign student/Students seeking admission/migration from any other Indian University will be required to attach the following additional documents with the admission form:
 - a) Original detailed marks certificate of the lower examination passed.
 - b) A transfer certificate from the head of Institute last attended.
 - c) Inter University migration certificate.
 - d) Eligibility certificate from Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar.
- 4. The Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any student without assigning any reason.
- 5. Admission to all classes of the college are made provisionally at the sole risk and responsibility of the student concerned and subject to the approval of the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar.
 - If it is not approved by the relevant authority for the reason that the student concerned has failed to provide the required documents in time or has hidden some information or given false information or is not eligible to join the class, the entire responsibility in such a case will lie with the student himself/herself. He/She will not be entitled to any claim, whatsoever, from the college in this respect.
- 6. Student will be responsible for completing all formalities at the college level with regard to paper less admission introduced by the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. College administration will not be responsible for false, incorrect, incomplete, misleading and non factual information provided by the student to the college as well as Guru Nanak Dev University for paper less admission.

OTHER CONDITIONS FOR THE ADMISSION

- 1. Foreigners with student visa will not be admitted without producing relevant documents.
- 2. Students who passed their last examination from Bihar Intermediate Education Council, Patna or other bogus/fake University (as per the UGC list) are not elibile for admission to the next class.
- 3. Candidates who passed +2 exam. from National Open School with four Subjects (including English) two Years after matriculation examination, are eligible for provisional admission to only B.A./B.Sc.-I (Pass course). They will have to appear for the fifth subject under the same group in the coming supplementary or Annual Examination conducted by Open School, New Delhi.
- 4. Admission will be done strictly in accordance with the number of seats approved by the university.

CHANGE OF SUBJECTS

A student with the concurrence of the teacher concerned and by the approval of the Principal may change a subject or subjects within a week of the date of commencement of the class by applying on the prescribed form available from the concerned student clerk. Application form for the change of subjects if not signed by the Father/Guardian shall be rejected.

For another period of seven days, the change of subjects of faculty to faculty is permitted on payment of a penalty of Rs. 50/- No change of subject will be allowed after 15 days except on very compassionate grounds, on payment of Rs. 100/- and that too for another 7 days only. Interalia change of subject by a student will be carried out as per the latest directions issued by Guru Nanak Dev University.

The college is affiliated to the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. It offers the following courses of study in different faculties.

FACULTY OF ARTS

B.A. Part I / II / III

Future Prospects: This three year programme familiarizes students with the intricacies and use of language in both formal and casual situations. Students gain knowledge in the literature, political, economic, historical, and psychological aspects of many situations through class room studies and social interaction. This programme allows students to select their own topic of interest among various subjects available. After completing the degree, students can appear in competitive examination or go for postgraduation in the any of the subjects studied in the programme.

Eligibility: A student who has passed +2 examination of PSEB/CBSE or any other equivalent examination, is eligible to join B.A. part - I.

Provisional Admission in B.A.-Sem-I :- A student having compartment in +2 examination, shall be admitted provisionally for B.A. 1st year. If he/she fails to clear the compartment till Dec. 2023 his/her candidature stands automatically cancelled and he/she shall have no claim whatsoever against college or university.

Subject combination for B.A. Part - I

Compulsory subjects:

- 1. General English
- 2. General Punjabi / Punjabi (Basic)

Elective Subjects: Any three choosing one each from the following groups:-

- 1. English/Hindi/Punjabi/Sanskrit (Elective)
- 2. Economics/Sociology
- 3. History/Mathematics
- 4. Computer Science/Physical Education
- 5. Political Science

B.A. Part-II, III

Eligibility: A student is eligible to join B.A. II/III if he/she has passed B.A I/II examination of GNDU respectively in same subject.

FACULTY OF SCIENCES

1) B.Sc. (Medical, Non-Medical) Part - I/II/III

Future Prospects: A student after passing B.Sc. (Medical/Non-Medical) can do post-graduation in following streams:

- i) M.Sc. Chemistry/Physics/Math (For non-medical students).
- ii) M.Sc. Chemistry / Botany / Zoology / Biochemistry / Microbiology/Genetics (for medical students)
- iii) M.C.A., M.B.A. (for non-medical Students)

After PG Course, the doors are open for research in physical, chemical and life sciences which has vast scope at University level and multinational companies. In addition, they can also do B.Ed.. They are also eligible for IAS, IPS, Central/ State allied services and Banking with a bright future ahead.

B.Sc. (Medical/Non-Medical) Part - I

Eligibility: A student who has passed +2 examination of PSEB/CBSE or any other equivalent examination with atleast 40% marks in science group is eligible to join B.Sc. - I (Med. / Non-Medical)

Compulsory subjects: 1. General English

2. General Punjabi

Elective Subjects:

B.Sc. (Non-Medical) - Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics

B.Sc. (Medical) - Chemistry, Botany, Zoology

B.Sc. Part - II/III (Medical / Non-Medical)

Eligibility: A student is eligible to join B.Sc. II/III if he/she has passed B.Sc. I/II exams respectively with same subjects.

Note: The students are advised to wear labcoats while working in laboratory in a college

2) B.Sc. (Computer Science) Part - I / II / III

Future Prospects: B.Sc. (Computer Science) is a three year degree program in computer science. The program covers the fundamentals of computer science along with stress on physics and mathematics. On completion of this course students can undertake further studies in M.Sc. (Maths), M.Sc. (Physics), M.Sc. (C.S.), M.Sc. (IT) etc. The program also provides a very good placement opportunity to the students in various sectors.

B.Sc. (Comp. Sc.) Part - I

Eligibility: A student who has passed +2 (Non-medical) from PSEB/CBSE or any other equivalent examination with atleast 40% marks. He/she shall study the following subjects:-

- General English
- General Punjabi
- Computer Science
- Physics
- Mathematics

B.Sc. (Computer Science) Part II/III:

Eligibility: A student who has passed B.Sc. I/II is eligible to join B.Sc. II/III respectively with same subject.

3) B. Sc. (Economics) Part - I, II, III

Future Prospects: A student after passing B.Sc. (Eco.) can also join PG course like M.Sc. (Eco.), M.C.A./M.B.A./M.Sc. (IT)/ M.A.(Eco.) A student of economics has good job prospects in banks, IT, marketing, Finance, BPO's, management, civil and Indian Economic Services.

B.Sc. (Eco.) Part - I

Eligibility: A student who has passed +2 examination of PSEB/CBSE or any other equivalent examination in any stream with atleast 40% marks is eligible to join B.Sc. (Eco.) Part-I. He/She shall study following subjects:

- General English
- General Punjabi
- Economics
- Computer Science
- Mathematics

Programmes Offered

B.Sc. (Eco.) Part - II / III

Eligibility: A student who has passed B.Sc. (Eco.) I/II, is eligible to join B.Sc. (Eco.) II / III respectively with same subjects.

4) M.Sc. (Mathematics)

Future Prospects :- This Post Graduate Program has been designed to produce professionals in Mathematics. After this Course Students can look for range of jobs in insurance companies, private & government banks, and the software companies etc. Students can even go for teaching in reputed institutes.

Eligibility: B.A./ B.Sc. with honours in Mathematics / Statistics/ Operational Research.

Or

B.A./ B.Sc. with 50 % Marks in aggregate and having mathematics as one of subjects.

Or

B.Sc. (Hons. School in Physics), B.Sc. (Engg.) with 50% marks in aggregate having mathematics as one of the subsidiary subjects.

Or

B.A./ B.Sc. in full subjects obtaining 45% marks in Mathematics.

Or

Master's Degree of this University in another subject of another faculty.

Or

Master's Degree in any subject from another University.

Faculty of Computer Science & IT

1) B.C.A. Part I/II/III

Future Prospects: B.C.A. is an ideal course for IT savvy students. B.C.A. is a full time three year program in computer applications. The program covers the details of computer applications.

On completion of this programme, a student can undertake further studies in M.C.A., M.B.A., M.Sc. (IT), M.Sc. (C.S.) etc. Students can undertake live projects from industry, so as to enable them to develop capabilities to solve real life problems. Being a professional job oriented course, the students can have a lot of placements in the IT sector, Banking sector, B.P.O. sector, call centres etc.

B.C.A. Part I

Eligibility: A student who has passed +2 of PSEB/CBSE or any other equivalent examination in any stream with atleast 40% marks is eligible to join B.C.A. Part - I. A student will study following papers:

A computer diploma courses are still in very high demand.

Eligibility: 10+2 in any stream with 40% marks.

4) **P.G.D.C.A.** (Post Graduate Diploma In Computer Application)

Eligibility: Graduate with Computer Science / I.T. /Computer application / Computer maintenance as one of elective subjects with 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

B.C.A. / B.Sc. (I.T.) / BIT or Equivalent with 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

Graduate with mathematics as an elective subject and Post-graduate Diploma in Computer Application / PG Diploma in information Technology / PG Diploma in E-Commerce & Internet application or equivalent course with 50% marks in the aggregate. Syllabi of M.Sc. (I.T.) and M.Sc. (Computer Science) will be notified later on.

FACULTY OF COMMERCE & MANAGEMENT

1) B.Com. Part I / II / III

Future Prospects: Bachelor of Commerce Students can look for lucrative job prospects especially in the accounting profile. They can also opt for professional courses like CA, CS, Cost and work Accountancy, Master Degree, B Ed, LLB etc. It provides knowledge and skills for accounts, taxation, business laws and business management that is crucial for starting and running business.

3) M. Com. Part I/II

Future Prospects: M.Com or Master of Commerce is a Post graduate 2 year degree Course that focuses on methodical learning of the concepts of Accountancy, Statistics, Finance, Taxation, Management Studies etc.

M.Com degree serves as a foundation for further advanced studies and research in this area such as M. Phil. and Ph.D in commerce.

Master of Commerce also opens scope for a wide range of Careers dealing with flow of money, from Accountant to investment banker, Money manager to personal Finance Consultant.

A M.Com. student may also go for UGC-NET or JRF Examination to pursue Careers in Teaching or research.

Eligibility: B.Com./BBA/B.CAM/Bachelor of E-Commerce with 50% in aggregate or equivalent Examination. *Syllabi of M.Com will be notified later on.*

Eligibility Conditions for University Examination

Compulsory Qualifying Examinations for UG Degree Courses:

1) Drug Abuse: Problem, Management and Prevention:

This is a new compulsory paper introduced in 1st year (Semester I and II) of all undergraduate degree courses.

2) Environmental Studies:

There is a compulsory qualifying paper, which the students have to study in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./BBA/BCA IInd year. The students are required to qualify this paper either in 2nd or 3rd year of the course. The examination is conducted by university. Eligibility Conditions for Admission to G.N.D.U. Examination in 2022-23.

The candidate shall be eligible to appear in the University examination if:

- 1. He/She has been on the rolls of the college throughout the academic year preceding the examination.
- 2. He/She has attended not less than 75% of the lectures delivered in each of the subject/papers offered (to be counted upto the last day when the classes are dispersed for the preparatory holidays)
 - For science students this shall be considered separately for practicals & theory.
- 3. He/She has obtained marks in either of the two house examinations as under:

B.A.: 35 per cent marks in each subject or 25 per cent in aggregate

B.Com.: 35 per cent marks in each subject.

OR

20 per cent marks in aggregate in each of the subject either in each of the two house examinations held by the college during the academic year or on the combined result of these examinations.

- 4. Candidate is required to show good conduct during the tenure of his/her being a bonafide student of the college.
- 5. That he has attended (in case of candidate offering Military Training) not less than 80 per cent of the parades to complete his trained cadet/man as required by the Regulations laid down by the Military Authorities for the office-in-charge of the National Cadet Corps. of N.C.C. Rifles or by the Sqn. Leader Air Cadets and countersigned by the Principal of the College.

Note: AS PER RULES/REGULATIONS OF THE G.N.D.U. A STUDENT WHO DOES NOT FULFILL ANY ONE OF THE CONDITIONS MENTIONED AS 1 TO 5 UPTO THE LAST DAY WHEN THE CLASSES ARE DISPERSED FOR PREPARATORY HOLIDAYS SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO APPEAR IN THE GURU NANAK DEV UNIVERSITY FINAL EXAMINATION, EVEN AS A PRIVATE CANDIDATE.

ATTENDANCE

HOUSE EXAMINATIONS

In order to assess the performance of the students of various classes, terminal examinations and other monthly tests are held from time to time. The date sheet of each examination will be notified to the students well in time.

All students are required to appear in the College Examinations which will be held in month of September and March for semester classes. The result of the terminal examinations will be considered for sending the admission forms of the students for University Examinations according to the rules and for the award of internal assessment wherever applicable.

The exemption from test will not be granted under any circumstances as it will determine the eligibility of a student for the final university examinations.

Absentees, without previous sanctioned leave, shall be fined Rs. 25/- per subject in a monthly test and Rs.100/- per subject in terminal house examinations.

A) STIPENDS, SCHOLARSHIPS & FEE CONCESSIONS

- Scholarships are available to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward class students as per D.P.I. rules. The concerned students are required to submit Caste certificate and Income certificate from the competent authority within prescribed time period.

- 3. The concession in fee, stipends and scholarships of all categories are conditional and liable to be withdrawn when a student deteriorates in studies or remains irregular in attendance or is found guilty of misbehaviour or fails to secure required percentage of marks in the house examination. In case a student migrates or leaves the college in the mid session he/she will be required to deposit the amount paid to him/her by way of concession in fees or stipends.

Faculty of Commerce & Management




